Three Days and Three Nights Fulfilled as Prophesied

Matthew 12:40

On a Lunar based calendar, as the Hebrew Calendar is, each month start is based on a lunar phase. On the Hebrew Calendar the first day of every month starts on the day after the New Moon. A problem using the Roman Calendar to calculate back, is to know when the exact time for the apex of the New Moon. If this occurs after sundown until midnight, it is on the following day as the Hebrew day starts at sundown, and the night comes before the day.

In the Roman year AD 30, the Moon Conjunction takes place the on Wednesday March 22, at 8p.m., after sunset. The Hebrew day would correspond to March 23, AD 30 and Month of Nisan first day corresponds to Roman Friday March 24, AD 30.

Sequence of events:

The Passover is on the 14th day of the first month, Nisan, starting on Roman Year AD 30, Wednesday April 5, at sundown.

The Lord's Supper in the middle of the night.

Betrayal and Illegal trial by night:

First the High Priest Mark 14:55-64

Peter denied Christ Mark 14:68-72

Trial before Pilate Night time Mark 15:2-14

Again trial before Pilate at daybreak John 19:13-14

Darkness from the sixth hour to the ninth hour, day 14 of Nisan, Roman Year AD 30, Thursday April 6. Mark 15:33-34

Jesus dies. The 14 day of Nisan, Roman Year AD 30, Thursday April 6. Mark 15:37, John 19:30, Luke 23:46, Matthew 27:50

Jesus removed from cross Before the High Sabbath John 19:31

In the tomb over both Sabbaths:

The High Sabbath, day 15 of Nisan. Roman year AD 30, April 7. Leviticus 23:6-7

The weekly Sabbath, day 16 of Nisan. Roman year AD 30, April 8. Genesis 2:2-4

Resurrection on the First day of the week, day 17 of Nisan. Roman year AD 30, April 9. Mark 16:1-2, John 20:1

Wave sheaf of the firstfruits, first day after the Sabbath, day 17 of Nisan. Leviticus 23:10

Count fifty days from the Wave Sheaf day to the Feast of Firstfruits, Pentacost. Leviticus 23:15-16
